Communication Intentions 0 - 36 months



How do you know if your child is meeting the milestones of communication development at a very young age? You can observe their communication intentions. From birth, babies communicate their needs and then communicate their wants. This video focuses on the development of communication intentions, how to identify them and what to expect from 0-36 months.
